Executive Order No. 06 – 2021

AN ORDER SIGNIFYING THE COMMITMENT OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF SAN ISIDRO TO THE ISABELA PROVINCIAL VACCINATION PLAN

WHEREAS: pursuant to the 1987 Constitution, the state Shall protect and promote the right to health of the people;

WHEREAS: Proclamation No. 922, s. 2020 was promulgated on March 8, 2020 declaring a State of Public health emergency throughout the Philippines due to Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19).

WHEREAS: Proclamation No. 929, s. 2020, dated March 16, 2020, declared a State of Calamity through the country for a period of six months due to Covid-19, which was extended until September 12, 2021 by pursuant to proclamation No. 1021;

WHEREAS: the declaration of State of Public Health Emergency capacitated government agencies and Local Government Units (LGUs) to immediately act to prevent loss of life, utilize appropriate resources to implement urgent and impact to the community, and prevent serious disruption of the functioning of the government and the community;

WHEREAS: pursuant to the above-mentioned declarations, all government agencies and LGUs are enjoined to continue rendering full assistance to and cooperate with each other and mobilize the necessary resources to undertake critical, urgent and appropriate disaster response aid and measures in timely manner to curtail and eliminate the threat of Covid-19;

WHEREAS: the national government ratified the Philippine National Deployment and Vaccination Plan for COVID-19 Vaccines and is now set to implement the nationwide immunization campaign to combat the coronavirus;

WHEREAS: the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) urged all Local Government Units (LGUs) to prepare a local vaccination plan as approved in the DOH Guidelines on the National Vaccination Program and coordinate closely with their respective DOH-Centers for Health Development in preparing this plan;

WHEREAS: for the Province of Isabela, the Isabela Provincial Vaccination Plan has already been presented and adopted by the Provincial Health Board and Provincial COVID-19 Task Force;

WHEREAS: among the requirements for submission and approval of said plan is a COMMITMENT from the component LGUs to support the program;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, VILMER B. BRAVO, Municipal Mayor do hereby signify the COMMITMENT of the Municipal Government of San Isidro to mobilize its available human and logistical resources for the implementation of the vaccination plan and assist the government in its vaccination advocacy campaign.
